

Dublin Gazette And it appearing that the Commissioners appointed pursuant to the Statute by his Certificate fixed the amount of Composition for Tithes in the said Parish of Karah at £559. 8. 0 sterling by the year of which said sum of £559. 8. 0 the sum of £221. 19. 9 sterling was due and payable by the year to Henry Sigginsbotham as Lay Impropriator of said Parish. And that the Rent Charge payable to the said Margaret Georgina Walsh and August J. Everard the present owners in lieu of said Composition was £166. 9. 10 being three fourths of the said sum of £221. 19. 9 And upon hearing the evidence given before the said Justices in open Court It is ordered by the said Justices that the said sum of £221. 19. 9 being the Composition mentioned in said Certificate as payable to the Lay Impropriator be diminished by the sum of £36. 10. 9 and that the same shall be £185. 9. 0 annually and that pursuant to the Statute 1+2 Victoria cap. 109 the Rent Charge in lieu of said reduced Composition of £185. 9. 0 shall be three fourths thereof that is to say a sum of £139. 1. 9 annually to be paid and payable to the parties entitled

and that same shall commence and be payable from the first day of November 1896 And it is further ordered that the assessment and apportionment of the said Composition shall be amended accordingly and that the apportionment of the Rectorial Tithe Rent Charge in lieu of said Composition so payable to the said Margaret Georgina Walsh and August J. Everard be reduced and diminished in like proportion.
