do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition
for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is one hundred and
five pounds eighteen shillings and four pence by the year the whole of
which sum of one hundred and five pounds eighteen shillings and
four pence is due and payable to the Reverend John Seymour as
a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of
the said Parish And We do further Certify that the average
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County
for the period of seven years ending the first day of November one
thousand eight hundred and twenty one is one pound eighteen
shillings and eight pence half penny per Bannell
