We the Commissioners appointed under the Tithes composition act, to approl, and assess, in the parish of Lea, nine hundred pounds, being the amount of composition agreed upon, by the parishioners assembled in Vestry, with the very Rev. Tho. French Dean of Kildare, entitled to the Rectorial Tithes, and the Rev. Rowd. G. Grange, the Vicar of the parish, equally, on all the land in the parish, have, according to the best of our judgment, and abilities, viewed every farm, and plot of ground, and have set forth, the quality of land contained in each, as compared, with the remainder of the parish, and the gross amount of acres, woods, and perches, taken in nearly all cases, from actual survey, either in the possession of the Landlords, or occupying tenant, We have divided the arable and pasture land, into four qualities, charging —
