In arranging this book, we have kept each town's land as nearly as possible separate, but we are aware, that in a few instances, we have not been quite correct, where the occupier has held land in two, or three, different townlands, but in all cases, we have kept the different properties quite distinct, The applotment and general table, is contained, in one hundred, and thirteen folio pages of this book, and there are four copies,

The average price of wheat, the corn principally grown in this parish, for the period of seven years, next preceeding the first day of November 1821, calculated upon the returns advertised in the Dublin gazette during such seven years, and according to which we signed our certificate, was $1\ 10\ \frac{2}{4}$ s.
