sums of fifty nine pounds ^{five} shillings and
ten pence, and said sum of fifteen pounds so
due and payable to the said parties aforesaid,
according to the provisions of the said act of 3 & 4th
Victoria, and also according to the instructions
contained in His Excellency's order appointing
me sole Comyns so to allot the sum—
