Copy of an Act of Vestry

Wednesday March 30th 1825

At a special vestry held this day in the Vestry Room of the Parish of the Union of Leixlip pursuant to Notice for the purpose of proceeding and carrying the Tithe composition Act into effect.

Resolved that the following Certificate of the Commissioners appointed under the said Act be read and entered, -

WE, the Reverend Caspar Conway John Howard and James Collier Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the 4th Chapter 99 Intituled "An Act to provide for the Establishment of composition for tithes, in Ireland for a limited time and an Act made in the fifth year of the said Reign Chapter 63 Intituled "An Act to amend the said first mentioned Act to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of the Union of Leixlip in the Counties of Dublin and Kildare. Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish of the Union of Leixlip is seven hundred ^{pounds} by the year of which sum of seven hundred pounds, the sum of fifty pounds is due and payable to
