duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made
in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth
& entitled "An act to provide for the establishing of
composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time,"
to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all the
tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the
Parish of Lemnagh, alias Kiltinaharna in the King's
County, do hereby certify that the true and just amount
of composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said
parish is four hundred and fifty pounds by the year
the whole of which sum is due and payable to the Crown.

Henry Graham as a composition for all tithes claimable
by him as Rector and Vicar of the said parish; And We do
further certify, that the ~~former~~ average price of Wheat
being the corn principally grown in ~~the~~ ^{the} parish
for the period of seven years ending on the first day of

November 1822 is one pound two shillings and six pence per barrel of Oats at eight
shillings & six pence per bushel
sworn under our hands this 9th Octob^r 1824
