 Do hereby Certify that the true and Just amount of Composition
 for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is One hundred
 and twenty seven Pounds nineteen Shillings by the year and
 We further Certify that the average price of oats being the Com
 principally grown in such County for the period of seven years
 next preceding the first of November one thousand eight hundred
 and twenty one is fifteen Shillings and two pence farthing
 per Barnell as appears from the average of the Dublin Gazette
