 for tithes in Ireland for a limited time," to ascertain and fix a true  
 and just Composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or  
 payable within the Parish of Leamy in the County of Westmeath  
 Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition  
 for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is One hundred &  
 twenty seven p. & a quarter shillings by the year And we further  
 Certify that the average price of oats being the Corn principally  
 grown in such County for the period of seven years next  
 preceding the first of November one thousand eight hundred and  
 twenty one is fifteen shillings and two pence farthing per Barrel  
 as appears from the *Register of the District of Leamy*  
 Dated the 1st of September 1824

 next, and some being during 3 years without variation  
 whatever price the Corn may be.

It was also unanimously agreed that  
 3. certificates sh. be agreed to, and that same sh. be invariable  
 for 21 years from 1<sup>st</sup> Nov. next & during 3 years with  
 variation whatever price the Corn may be.
