that the true and just amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatever within ^{the} said Parish, is three hundred
Pounds. ~~of~~ of which sum of three hundred Pounds
five month parts, being one hundred and sixty six
Pounds thirteen Shillings and seven pence, are due
and payabll to the Reverend Chaworth Browne as a
Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Vicar
of the said Parish, and the remaining four month parts being
one hundred and thirty three Pounds, six Shillings and
eight pence, are due and payabll to the Most Noble
the Marquis of Westmeath, as lay Proprietor of said
Parish - And we do further certify that the average price
of Oats, being the Grain principally grown in said County
for the period of seven Year ending the first day of
November 1821 is fifteen Shillings and two pence
fourthing per Bush - Dated this 8 day of June 1826
