Commissioners duly appointed & sworn under & by virtue
of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King
George the fourth entitled an act to provide for the establish-
ing a composition of Tythes in Ireland for a limited time
to ascertain & fix a true & just composition for all Tythes
whatsoever arising, growing, yielding, or payable within
the Parish of Licknoldaffy, County of Galway, Do hereby
certify that the true & just amount of composition for all
Tythes whatsoever within the said Parish is Three hundred
pounds Sterling Two hundred & fifty pounds due and
payable to the Revd John Armstrong Rector & Vicar of
the Parish, & fifty pounds to the Lord Bishop of Confort.
And we do further certify that the average price
of Oats being the Corn principally grown in the County
for the period of seven years ending on the first day
of Nov^r 1821 one is fifteen shillings & 4*1/4* per Barrel
(in 11 bushels) or 1000 bushels 15*1/4* per barrel.
