 Comproamis for all Tithes wholsum within  
 the said parish is one hundred and sixty  
 pounds Two Shillings and Six pence All  
 by the year of which Sum of £160<sup>0</sup> 2<sup>0</sup> 6  
 is payable to the Hon<sup>ble</sup> W<sup>th</sup> Browne  
 as Comproamis for the Tithes claimable by him as Vicar  
 of the said parish one fourth and a half  
 is due and payable to the Very Rev<sup>d</sup> the  
 Carter Deane of Quaine as Comproamis
