

Certificate of Composition

We William Howard Holland Senior and William Howard Holland Junior Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth intitled "An Act to provide for the establishment of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Lisacloy in the County of Cork do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is One hundred and Eighty pounds Late Irish Currency (which is equivalent to One hundred and sixty six pounds three shillings and three farthings British Currency) by the year. Of which sum of One hundred and sixty six pounds three shillings and three farthings the entire is due and payable to the Reverend John Fortescue Prebendary and Vicar of the said Parish. Which sum is calculated as follows One hundred and fifty pounds is the average amount of the seven years ending the first of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty one to which we have added thirty pounds being one fifth of said average

and which we have thought fit to add in consequence of the Tithes of said Parish having been let by the late Incumbent for a long term of years previously for a sum below their present value

And we do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County for the Period of seven years ending the first of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty one is one pound eight shillings and eight pence Sterling per Barrel
