

We the undersigned being Commissioners duly appointed for the Parish of Lisacloy under and Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth (entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of Composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time) do hereby certify that the foregoing Valuation and Apportionment is a true and just Return as taken by us

The foregoing Certificate having been appealed against by the Rev John Fortson Archdeacon of said Ireland to the Privy Council of Ireland and afterwards by Consent referred to the Lord Judge of Assize for the County of Galway the same came on to be heard at Spring Assizes 1828 for said County,

When an Order to modify said Certificate to the Import following was made

By Consent of all parties by the Lord Judge  
"By Consent of the Appellant and Respondents given in open Court - Let the Certificate be modified by increasing the amount of the Composition from the sum of One Hundred and forty six pounds three shillings and three farthings to the sum of Two Hundred and ten pounds and let the clause in the said Certificate commencing with the words "which sum is calculated" and ending with the words "beside their present value" be struck out of the said Certificate. The Appellant undertaking in open Court to accept at the rate of the yearly sum of One Hundred and forty six pounds three shillings and three farthings in lieu of all Tithes due and payable for the two years ending on the first day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven and to give Credit for all sums already paid for or on account of such Tithes,

And let the Appellant pay to the Respondents all Costs incurred by them in relation to the said Appeal down to the time of the making of the Order referring the said Appeal to the Judge of Assize including the Costs of the said Order, the Costs to be taxed and ascertained by the proper Officer. And let the parties Appellant and Respondents abide their own Costs respectively as to all subsequent proceedings - And let the Commissioners proceed forthwith to apply said sum of Two Hundred
