of the reign of King George the fourth Cap 63. entitled an Act to provide for the  
establishing of Composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time

farm in said Parish and that we have apportioned the sum of Ninety pounds  
which the Rector is entitled to receive as Composition for the tithes in fair just  
and equitable proportions according to the value of the land to the best of our  
Skill and judgment which proportions are Correctly stated in the foregoing  
apposite to the name of each Occupier here under our hands this fifth day of May  
one thousand eight hundred and twenty six
