

I Lewis McManis a Commissiona duly appointed
and sworn unto and by Virtue of an Act passed
in the second and third years of the Reign of his
present Majesty King William the Fourth "intituled an
Act to amend the laws of Ireland respectively in the
fourth fifth, and eighth years of the Reign of
late Majesty King George the fourth providing for
the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland
and to make such Compositions permanent, to
ascertain and fix a true and just composition for the
impropriate Tithes arising, growing, yielding or pay-
able within the Parish of Lisgoole in the Diocese of
Cloyne and County of Cork. Do hereby certify
that the true and just amount of composition for
said Tithes in said Parish is the Hundred and
Eighteen Pounds fourteen Shillings, is due ^{by the year} and payable
to Elizabeth Sully the elder, Elizabeth Sully the younger
and Griselda Sully all of Middleton in said County
being the Heirs to the late Lessee of the lay Impropri-
-ates

And I do further certify that the
average price of oats being the crop principally grown
in said Parish for the period of seven years ending
the first day of November the thousand eight hundred
and thirty is Twelve Shillings and eleven pence
half penny per Bushel.
