Within the Parish of Lisgoole in the County of Cork do hereby certify
that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within said Parish is Ninety Pounds. By the year the whole of which
Sum of Ninety Pounds is due and payable to the Rev^d William May
Mansell as a Composition for all Tithes claimable by him as
Vicar of said Parish

And we do further Certify that the said sum of Ninety Pounds
by the year is to remain and continue as the true and just amount of
Composition for all Tithes claimable by him within said Parish
Without Variation for Twenty one years from the first day of May next
ensuing the date Hereof whatever the Price of Corn may be
Given Under our Hands this Tenth day of April 1825 Twenty five
