

To all to whom these presents shall come I the Reverent  
Thomas Ottwell Moore Incumbent of the Parish of Leskinfane  
in the County of Wexford send greeting - Whereas  
Edward Berner of the City of Dublin Esquire Doctor of  
Medicine has truly served me with a notice in writing  
in the words and figures following -

Sir

"You are hereby required to take notice that in  
"pursuance of an act passed in the second and third  
"year of His present Majesty entitled "an act to amend  
"three acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and  
"in the seventh and eight years of the reign of His late  
"Majesty King George the fourth, providing for  
"establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland, and  
"to make such compositions permanent"

I Edward Berner of the City of Dublin Esq. (Doctor of  
Medicine, being seized in fee simple of all that and  
those the Lands of Tomkyle and ~~Ballintea~~  
situate in the Parish of Leskinfane, Barony of Gorey  
and County of Wexford, or otherwise intitled according to  
the provisions of said act to agree for and undertake the  
payment of the composition for tithes lawfully payable  
for and in respect of such lands do hereby signify to you my  
desire to agree for, and undertake the payment of such  
composition as aforesaid, for and in respect of the said  
lands and I hereby require you to grant me a certificate  
in writing conformable to the provisions of the said act  
declaring me entitled to the benefit of this notice and to  
perform the other matters on your part required by the  
said act to be done - Dated this 21<sup>st</sup> day of October 1834  
Edward Berner

Now I the said Thomas Ottwell Moore Rector and  
Incumbent of the said Parish of Leskinfane, do by this  
certificate under my hand and seal acknowledge the  
receipt of said notice and do certify and declare that  
the said Edward Berner is entitled to the benefit of the
