

To all to whom these Presents shall come, I, the
Rev^d Thomas Ottwell Moore, Incumbent of the Parish
of Leshinfore, in the County of Weasford, send greeting
whereas John G. Richards Esq^r of Ardaraire in the
County of Weasford has truly served me with a notice in
writing, in the words and figures following—

" Sir,

" you are hereby required to take notice, that in pur-
" -suance of an Act passed in the second and third year
" of his present Majesty, entitled 'An Act to amend three
" Acts passed respectively, the fourth, fifth and in the seventh
" and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty, King George
" the fourth, providing for the Establishment of Compositions
" for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions perma-
" -nent' I John G. Richards of Ardaraire, in the County
" of Weasford, being seized in fee simple of all that and
" those, the Town Lands of Tubbororan and Ballinmore
" situate in the Parish of Leshinfore, Barony of Long and
" County of Weasford, or otherwise entitled according to the
" provisions of said Act, to agree for, and undertake the
" payment of the Compositions for Tithes lawfully payable
" for and in respect of such Lands, do hereby signify
" to you my desire to agree for and undertake the pay-
" ment of such Compositions as aforesaid, for and in
" respect of the said Lands—and I hereby require you to
" grant me a Certificate in writing conformable to the
" provisions of said Act, declaring me entitled to the
" benefit of this notice, and to perform the other matters
" on your part required by the said Act to be done—

to the said several Lands and premises in said notice mentioned, and
charged with the Compositions for Tithes for said Parish, and which Lands
are more particularly delineated and set forth in the Map, Plan, Chart
or Ground Plan, thereof signed by me & known to answer—
