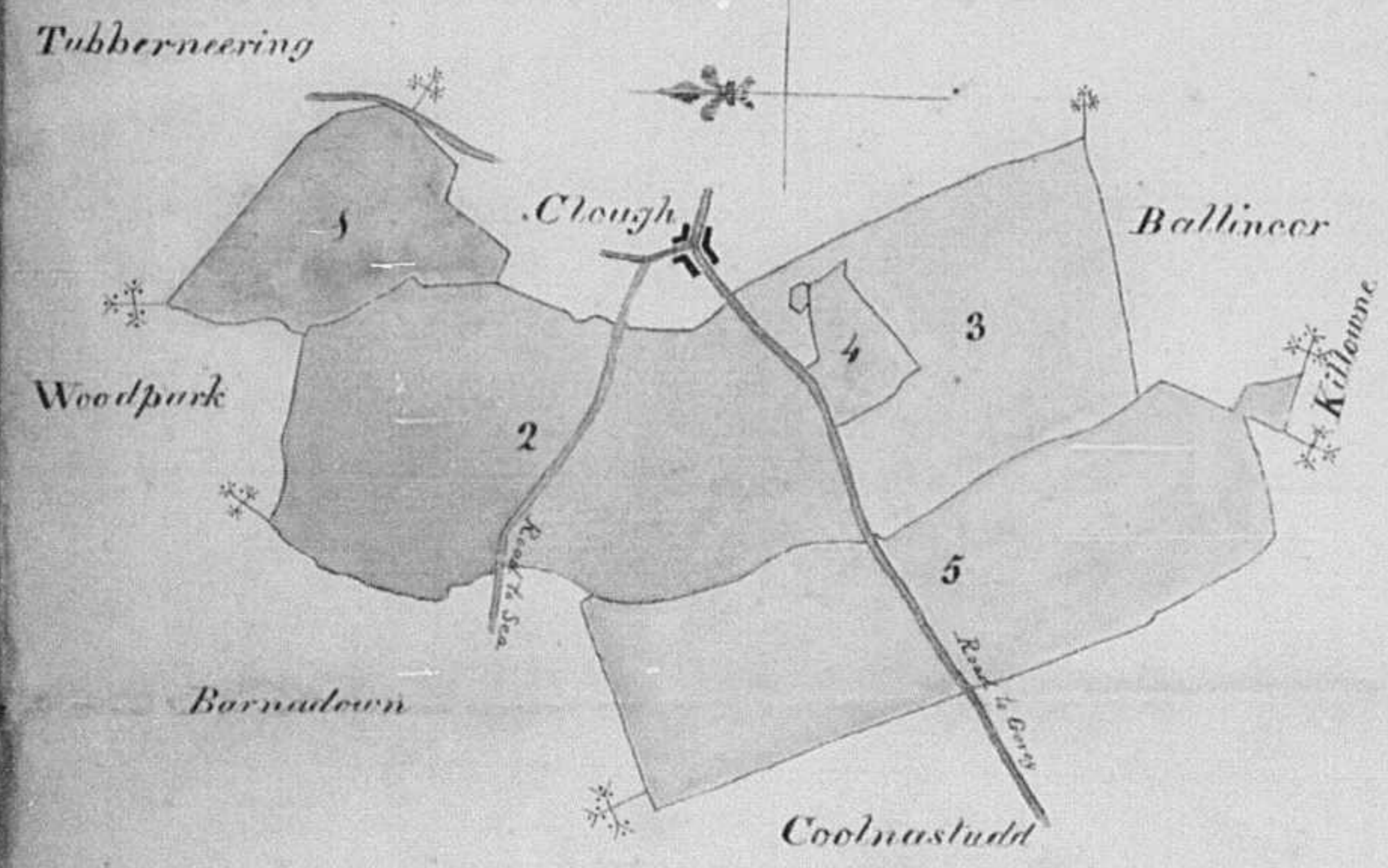


Whereas I the Rev<sup>d</sup> Thomas O'Mullin  
 Moore Rector of the Parish of Leskinfare,  
 under & by virtue of an act passed in  
 the second and third year of the reign  
 of His Majesty King William the fourth  
 Entitled an act to amend three acts passed  
 respectively in fourth and fifth, seventh  
 and eighth year of the reign of his late  
 Majesty King George the fourth, providing  
 for the establishing of the Composition of  
 Tithes in Ireland, and to make such  
 Compositions permanent, have received  
 a notice from the Rev<sup>d</sup> Abel Lohu Rame  
 of Clonatin in the County of Wexford in  
 the following form -

" Sir, Take notice that I am desirous  
 of agreeing for and undertaking the future  
 payment of Compositions for Tithes on  
 the Lowlands of Churchtown, Cain  
 Moneycross and Moneylane as shown  
 by the annexed Map in the margin  
 hereof of which I am the Landlord  
 and which contain Six Hundred and  
 sixty one acres one rood and eleven  
 perches Calc Irish measurement or  
 thereabouts and are bounded on the  
 north by Woodpark & Tubberneering on  
 East by Barnadown & Coolmashudd  
 south south by Ballinacor & Killanure and  
 south west by Clough - being situated  
 in the Parish of Leskinfare, Barony of Gore,  
 and County of Wexford Dated this 10<sup>th</sup>  
 of October 1834" (Signed) Abel John Rame  
 Leskinfare
