Arthur Belcher of Glenpipe Lodge, Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made in the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> years of the Reign of King William the IV. intituled an Act to amend three Acts, pass<sup>d</sup> respectively in the 1<sup>st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & in the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent To ascertain and fix a true & just Composition for all the Tithes arising, growing, or payable within the Townland of Lesmatique in the union of Bunnchurch in the County of Wickham

do hereby certify that the true and just Amount of Compositions for all the Tithes whatever within the said Townland, is One Hundred Pounds Sterling - which is due and payable to the Rev Richard Butler, as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him, as Rector & Vicar of said Town Land. And I do further certify that the Average price of Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in D. County for the period of seven years, ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 1830 (Thirty) is One Pound Twelve Shillings & one half penny per Barrel
