by him as Lay Impignator, and Five hundred and
Forty five pounds nine shillings and six pence sterling
are due and payable to the Rev. James Stewart the
vicar of said Parish. And I do further certify, that the
average price of wheat, being the corn principally grown
in such county, for the period of seven years next preceding
the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and
and Thirty, is one pound Twelve shillings and ten pence half
penny ^{sterling} per barrel.
