

We John Musgrave and Thomas Foley Commissioners duly appointed
and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of
the Reign of King George the fourth entitled "an act to provide for the establishing
of Compositions for Sythes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain
and fix a true and just composition for all Sythes arising growing
yield or payable in a Certain distinct district in the Parish of Lismore
and Moolelop consisting of the Town Lands hereinafter mentioned and
their Subdivisions and also out of the Blue Water Salmon Fishery
within said Parish all in the Diocese of Lismore and Counties of
Waterford and Cork Do hereby certify that the true and just amount
of composition for all Sythes whatever within or out of said district and
Salmon Fishery is one thousand seven hundred pounds per annum as
agreed upon at a Special Vestry duly held pursuant to said act in the
Cathedral Church of Lismore on the first day of November one thousand
Eight hundred and twenty four. And we further certify that the entire
Sythes arising out of Shanely Gapra your O'Neil and Bungess Land
of Lismore except the Cattle quarter Ballysaggartmore foolishly the two
Ballyduff Glenley Leglagordy part of Littlepage and a small part of
Ballinlwave called Lyre are payable to the Vicars Choral of the Cathedral
Church of Lismore we further certify that the entire Sythes arising out of
Ballynelyan (being the Treasurers Land) the Chanters Land and Archdeaconry
Glebe and Glemoniesments belong to the Economy and are payable to
the Dean and Chapter of said Cathedral we further certify that of
the Sythes of Curraheen one half belongs to the said Economy and is
payable to the said Dean and Chapter and the other half is payable
to the said Vicars Choral we further certify that of the Sythes of the
Lands next herein after mentioned and the said Salmon fishery two thirds
belong to the said Economy and are payable to the Said Dean & Chapter and the
remaining one third is payable to the Said Vicars Choral Mr. Affane Norisland
Ballymkin Ballymadana Ballyeara Ballyfin and the said Salmon fishery
Ballygallan Ballyrafter Ballysaggartby Ballinville Ballinaspy Ballyonash
Ballynarrow the two Brodans Ballinlwave (except a part called Lyre).
