or 5^s Sterling good likewise for tillage and grazing the third Class to be of the
assessable value of 20^d Pounds six Shillings Sterling and good for feeding and tillage
and the fourth Class of the Mountain and Bottom land fit for feeding and rearing
Young Cattle to be of the assessable annual value of 10^d or 1^s Sterling
