and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of
King George the fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of compositions
for Tythes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for all Tythes whatsoever arising growing yielded or payable within the
Parish of Lisconniff in the County of Roscommon, do hereby certify, that the true and just
Amount of composition for all Tythes whatsoever within the said Parish is Two hundred
and eighty Pounds Sterling by the year, of which the Sum of one hundred and Sixty four
Pounds is due and payable to The Reverend Edward Mahon as Vicar of the said Parish
and the Sum of one hundred and sixteen Pounds Sterling is due and payable to the
Reverend John Brunkley as Rector of said ^{Parish} as a composition for all Tythes claimable by him

And we do hereby further certify that the Average price of oats being the corn
principally grown in said County is 15 2/4 per Burreale for the period
of seven years next preceeding the first day of November one thousand eight hundred
and Twenty one, Dated this 29th day of October 1825
