Listowale in the County of Kerry do hereby Certi-  
fy that the just & true amount of Composition  
for all Tithes whatsoever within said Parish is Two  
hundred and fourteen pounds by the Year of which  
Sum of Two hundred & fourteen pounds one half is  
due and payable to Thomas Haughton Esq. as owner  
of the vicarual Tithes and one half is due & payable  
to the Rev. Mr. Henry Haughton the Vicar of said Parish.

And we further Certify that the average price  
of Oats being the Com. principally grown in such  
County, in the period of seven Years ending on the  
last Day of November 1821 is fifteen Shillings  
Board. Given under our hands this 12<sup>th</sup> Day  
of October 1824.
