Joseph Rogers, Commissioners duly appointed and Sworn, under and by Virtue of an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled, an Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Lorka Diocese of Killaloe and County of Tipperary do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Four Hundred and Seventy Five Pounds Sterling by the Year, the entire of which Sum is due and payable to the Rev. Edu. Duce Archdeacon of Killaloe as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish and we do further Certify the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of Seven Years ending the first of November 1824 is One Pound Eighteen Shillings & Eight Pence per Barrel.
