an Act to provide for the Establisling of Compositions for Tythes in
Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and Just
composition for all tythes arising growing yielded or payable
Within the Parish of Loughrea in the County of Galway, do
hereby Certify that the true and Just amount of compositions for
all tythes whatever within the Said Parish is One Hundred
Sixty seven pounds nine shillings & ten pence half penny
by the year of which Sum One Hundred Forty two pounds
Nine shillings and ten pence half penny
are due and payable to the Rev^d Denis Brown as a composition for
the tythe claimable by him as Rector of the Said Parish, and
Twenty five pounds is due and payable to the Very Rev^d Dean
Hawkins as Dean of Clontarf and we do further Certify that the
average price of wheat being the corn principally grown in such
County for the period of Seven years ending on the thirty first
day of October 1821 is One Pound eighteen shillings and eight pence
half penny of Barnet, Given Under our hands and Seals
this twentieth day of September 1825 five
