for all tythes arising growing yielded or payable within
the Parish of Keshbeg in the County of Galway do
hereby Certify that the true and Just Amount of
composition for all tythes whatsoever within the Said
Parish is One Hundred and Sixty Seven Pounds
Nine Shillings Ten pence half penny by the year of which
Sum One hundred and forty two Pounds nine
Shillings Ten pence half penny are due and payable
to the Rev Denis Brown as a Composition for thirty three
claimable by him as Rector of the Said Parish and
twenty five Pounds is due and payable to the Very Rev
Dane Hawkins as Deane of Clonfert, And we do
further Certify that the Average price of wheat being the
corn principally grown in Such County for the Period
of Seven years ending on the thirty first day of October
1821 is One Pound eighteen Shillings and eight pence half
penny & Band Given Under Our hands & Seals
