

I Edwyn Hoskyns (Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the Second and Third Year of the Reign of King William the Fourth, intituled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, Providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Lusk in the County of Dublin) do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Nine Hundred and Eighty five Pounds Eight Shillings and Six Pence Three Farthings by the Year. Of which sum of £ 985..8..6<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> - £ 881..8..6<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> is due and payable to Georges Cuthbert Esq. as a Composition for the Tithes claimed by him as Executor to the late Geo. Blackford Esq. Lessee of the Precentor and Treasurer of the Cathedral Church of Saint Patrick to whom the Rectorial or Great Tithes of said Parish belong, except those portions of it called Grace Dieu and the Riglas. and a sum of £ 50 - is due and payable to Lord Viscount Thurlston as owner of the Tithes of Grace Dieu. And a sum of £ 40 - by the Year is due and payable to The Rev. Rosingrave Mecklen as Vicar of said Parish. and a sum of £ 14 - by the Year is due and payable to Edw. Syng Esq. as owner of the Tithes of the Riglas. X
