the Tithes of Gracedieu as Lessee of Lord Trimleston
but has not produced his Lease and that no Tithes
have been paid in Grace Dieu from time immemorial -

And I do further Certify that the average
price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in
said County for the period of seven years ending on
the First of Nov^r 1830 is £1-12-0^r & Barrel -
