

An Applotment of the Tithes of Parish of Lusk, in the Diocese and County of Dublin.

1st) The Great or Rectorial Tithes.

I find that the Net number of acres chargeable with the great or Rectorial Tithes is 8320 $\frac{3}{4}$, upon which the Sum of £ 881^s 8^d 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ is to be raised. I have divided the land into three several and distinct Classes as follows.
