chargeable within the S^d parish is 113 by the year of which
sum of one Hundred and thirteen pounds the sum of
Twenty eight pounds is due to the incumbent by the
year as a composition for all tithes due to him in
parish and the sum of twenty pounds to the Bishop
of Clonfert as a composition for all tithes due to him
in said parish and the sum of fifteen pounds
to the Archdeacon in said Clonfert as the Compensa-
-tion of all tithes due to him in said parish.

and we do certify that the average price
of wheat is 2-9-11³/₄ Barrel & oats in the Kings Co^{ty}
being the best principally grown in said parish
