and fix a true & just Compensation for all tithes arising
growing or payable within the parish of Lismagh
in the Kings County do hereby certify that the true & just
amount of compensation for all tithes whatever within the said
parish is 113- by the year of which sum of one hundred & thirteen
pounds the sum of 20 pounds is due to the Incumbent by the year as a compensation
for all tithes due to him in said parish and the sum of seventy
pounds to the Bishop of Clonfert as a compensation for all
tithes due to him in said parish & the sum of fifteen pounds
to the Archdeacon in Clonfert as the compensation for all tithes
due to him in said parish

and we do certify that the average price of wheat
is 1-2-9 & oats is 10^s per Barrel being the corn principally
grown in said parish
