made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the  
fourth intituled an Act to provide for the establishment  
of composition for Tithes in Ireland, for a limited time  
to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for  
all tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable, within  
the parish of Lym in the County of Westmeath.

So hereby certify that the true and just amount of  
composition for all tithes whatever within Said parish is  
One Hundred and eighty pounds Sterling by the year,  
and the whole sum is due and payable to the Rev. Messrs  
Dennis as Rector of Said parish as a composition due  
and claimable by him for the tithes of Said parish  
of Lym.
