fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising,
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of
Mareston in the County of Meath, do hereby certify
that the true and just amount of Composition for
all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Sixty
eight pounds by the year: of which Sum of Sixty eight
pounds, Fifty eight pounds are due and payable to
the Marquis of Drogheda or his Representative as owner
of Rectorial Tithes in the said Parish and to any other
owner of Rectorial Tithes in the said Parish, And Ten
