Sum of one thousand and thirty pounds
Four hundred and thirty pounds are due
and payable to the Rev. Patrik Mathias
Cumming the Vicar of said Parish by
agreement to continue invariable for
Twenty one Years and Six hundred pounds
are due and payable to John Boyle
Kierman Esq. as Lessee of the Rectorial
and Impropriate tithes of said Parish
to continue by agreement invariable
for Twenty one Years And We do
further certify that the average
Price of Oats being the *locus principalis*
growen in said County for the
period
