hundred and <sup>Forty Three</sup> ~~Thirty~~ pounds are due and  
payable to the Reverend Patrick Mathias  
Curving the Vicar of said Parish by  
agreement to continue invariable for Twenty  
and Eighty six <sup>years</sup> ~~years~~ and four <sup>months</sup> ~~months~~  
One Year and Six hundred pounds are due  
and
