

Certificate of Composition for the Parish of Carrick
in Ross in the Diocese of Clogher County of Monaghan
from the first of November 1823 for twenty one years

We Samuel Wainright and Thos. Merrin Commissioners duly
appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth
Year of the Reign of King George the fourth intituled an Act to provide for
the Establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland for a limited time
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tythes growing
arising yielded or payable within the said parish of Carrick in Ross in
the County of Monaghan Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all Tythes whatsoever within the said parish is one thousand
and fifty pounds by the year, of which sum of one thousand and fifty
pounds two third parts are due and payable to the Rev. William
Pinching as a Composition for the tythe claimable by him as Vicar of
the said parish, and one third part is due and payable to John Boyle
Keenan Esq. Lessee in perpetuity of the Impropriator of said Parish
And We do further Certify that the average price of oats being the
corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years ending
on the first day of November 1823 is fifteen shillings and two pence one farthing
per Bushel
