 duly appointed and sworn under and by
 virtue of an Act made in the fourth year
 of the reign of King George the fourth
 intitled an Act to provide for the establishment
 of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for
 a limited time to ascertain and fix a true
 and just composition for all tithes arising
 growing yielding or payable within the
 Parish of Mogorban in the Co of Tipperary
 do hereby certify that the true and just
 amount of composition for all tithes
 whatever within the said parish is £230
 by the year which sum of £230 are due
 and payable to his grace the Lord Archbishop
 of Cashel as a composition for the tithes
 claimable by him as appropriator of
 said Parish by a special agreement
 entered into between him and the former
 Parishioners for the term of twentyone
 years from the first day of November
 1828 eight. And we do further certify that
 the average price of wheat being the corn
 principally grown in such County for
 the space of seven years ending the 1st of Nov
 1821 are is £1. 18. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ per barrel - Dated
 the 3rd Oct 1828 eight. James H. Ryall }
