

5848 2<sup>d</sup> & 3<sup>d</sup> of William 4<sup>th</sup> Chap. 119.

I Bruce White Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the second and third year of the Reign of King William the fourth Chap. 119 entitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth & in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent - to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Maloonagh in the County of Limerick and Diocese of Limerick Do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Five hundred pounds Sterling by the year and which sum of Five hundred pounds Sterling is due and payable to the Reverend Thomas Locke as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish. And I do further Certify that the Average prices of Wheat Barley & oats being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period
