missioners duly appointed and sworn, under and by
virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign
of King George the fourth, intituled, "An Act to provide
for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time," to ascertain and fix a true and
just composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded,
or payable within the Parish of Malahide, in the County
of Dublin, do hereby certify, that the true and just
amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within
the said Parish is one hundred and twenty pounds
by the year. the entire of which sum is due and payable
to the Rev^d Francis Chamley, the ecclesiastical incumbent
of the said Parish.

And we do further certify, that the average price
of wheat, being the corn principally grown in such County,
for the period of seven years, ending on the first day of
November 1821 is thirty eight shillings per Barrel.
