

Malahide 23<sup>rd</sup> October 1823

My Lord

I have the Honor of Acknowledging to your Grace, that  
at a Special Vestry duly assembled on Monday the  
13<sup>th</sup> Inst, consisting of upwards of seven persons  
of which Vestry I have been elected (Chairman) It  
was agreed between the Parishioners and the  
Ecclesiastical Incumbent, who alone is entitled  
to the Tithe of this parish, to carry into execution  
the purposes of the Act of the 4<sup>th</sup> of the King 22 79  
which agreement was reduced into writing and  
signed by the said Incumbent and seven of the  
Parishioners present at said Vestry And at an  
Adjourned meeting of said Vestry, at which  
seven persons were present duly assembled  
on Monday the 20<sup>th</sup> of October Instant John  
Lepine Esq<sup>r</sup> of Malahide in the Parish  
of Swords and County of Dublin Esq<sup>r</sup> was  
unanimously elected Nominated and appointed  
Commissioner on behalf of all the Owners and  
Occupiers of Land within the Parish of  
Malahide for carrying into execution the  
purpose
