 made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George
 the fourth intitled an Act to provide for the Establish-
 ment of Composition for Tythes in Ireland and also
 an Amendment of said Act passed in the fifth year
 of the Reign of King George the fourth to ascertain
 and fix a true and just Composition for all Tythes
 arising growing yielding & payable within the
 Parish of Malahackstown in the County of Wick
 and Diocese of Down do hereby Certify that the
 true and just amount of Composition for all
 Tythes whatsoever within the said Parish is one
 Hundred and Eighty five Pounds six Shillings
 and ten pence Sterling p^a annum which sum
 is due and Payable to the Rev^d Tho^s Kemmis as
 Rector and Vicar of said Parish and we do further
 Certify that the said sum of one Hundred and
 Eighty five pounds six Shillings & ten pence
 is a just & fair Composition for said Tythes
 as agreed upon at a Vestry duly assembled for
 the full and term of Twenty One years with-
 out any Variation of Prices dated this 17th day
 of August 1825
