

I Thomas Sherrard Jun<sup>r</sup> having been duly appointed and sworn a Commissioner under and by virtue of an act made in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years of the reign of King William the Fourth, Intituled "an Act to amend Three acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent." to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Manfieldstown in the County of Louth, do hereby certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes what ever within the said Parish, is Two Hundred and Seventy one pounds nine shillings and eight pence half penny sterling, by the year, the entire of which sum £271. 9. 8<sup>½</sup> is due and payable to the Reverend George Vesey as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector, and sole owner of the Tithe of said Parish.

And I do further certify That the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years, ending on the first day of November 1830, is Thirty two shillings and ten pence half penny sterling per Barrel
