

I Frederick William Greaves Commissioner duly appointed
and sworn under and by virtue of an Act passed in the
Second and Third Years of the Reign of His Majesty King William
the Fourth intituled An Act to amend Three Acts passed
respectively in the Fourth Fifth and in the Seventh and Eighth
years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth
providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for
all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the
Parish of Marmullane in the County of Cork; do hereby
Certify that the true and just amount of Compositions
for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is
Sixty nine pounds by the Year being the sum agreed
upon between the Parishioners and the Owner of the Tithes
of said parish which sum of Sixty nine pounds is due and
payable to The Reverend Richard Lloyd as a Composition
for the Tithes claimable by him as Owner of the Rectorial
and Vicarial Tithes of the said Parish —

And I do further Certify that the average price of
Wheat in such County for the period of Seven Years ending
on the First day of November 1830 Thirty is One pound Twelve
Shillings and One halfpenny per Barrel — and that the
average price of Oats in such County for the period of
Seven Years ending on the First day of November 1830 Thirty
is Twelve Shillings and Eleven pence halfpenny per Barrel — as
published in the Dublin Gazette. —
