By the Justices assigned to keep the Peace in and for the  
County of Cork assembled at a General Quarter Session of  
the Peace holden at Fermoy in and for the Division of  
Middleton in Cork County East Riding on Thursday  
the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1872.

Whereas due Notice having been first affixed at the  
times and in the manner directed by the Statutes in such  
Case made and provided by the said Rev<sup>d</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Henry Nason  
the Lay Impropriator of said Parish the person receiving  
and entitled to receive the Rent charge payable in lieu  
of the Composition for all the Impropriate Tithes within  
such Parish made by the Certificate of Roger Sheehy Dowdall  
and John Fitzgibbon Commissioners bearing date the  
8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1830 and in pursuance of the Statutes  
in such Case made and provided and by which Certificate  
the gross amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever  
in said Parish was Certified to be the Annual sum of  
Three hundred and thirty Pounds. Whereas one half  
to wit the sum of One hundred and Sixty five Pounds was  
Certified to be due and payable to The Rev J. S. Cotter the then  
Vicar of said Parish each and every year and the other half thereof  
to wit the like sum of One hundred and Sixty five Pounds was Certified  
to be payable to John Nason Esquire the then Lay Impropriator of said
