

November next ensuing shall bear the like proportion to the amount of the Composition set forth in the said Certificate dated the 27th day of October 1821 as the said sum of $\text{£}110\frac{1}{2}$ the average price of Corn that is to say Wheat and Oats per Barrel of Wheat of 20 stones and $14\frac{1}{2}$ stones of Oats ascertained from the said Gazette for the period of 7 years preceding this application shall bear to the said sum of $\text{£}110\frac{1}{2}$ stating the average price of Corn that is to say Wheat and Oats per Barrel of 20 stones of Wheat and $14\frac{1}{2}$ stones of Oats ascertained from the said Dublin Gazette for the 7 years preceding the 1st day of November 1821 being the period in reference whereunto the said Composition was calculated and that the Assessment and appointment of such Composition shall be diminished so as to bear the like proportions to the amount of Composition for and during such next ensuing several years as the original Assessment and appointment did bear to such original Composition and that the annual Rent charges payable in lieu thereof shall be diminished in like proportion that is to say from

the sum of $\text{£}130$ Irish Currency equal to $\text{£}120$ Sterling to the sum of $\text{£}71\text{..}19\text{..}7$ Sterling)
