Now it is accordingly Ordered and  
adjudged that the annual rent charge  
in lieu of composition for all tithes  
within the said Parish of Martry in  
the County of Meath shall be dimin-  
-ished in such manner and to such  
extent that the amount of such  
Composition payable for and during  
the 7 years from the 1st November  
next ensuing shall bear the like proportion  
to the amount of the composition set  
forth in the said Certificate dated the  
27 day of October 1824 as the said sum  
of  $14/10\frac{3}{4}$  the average price of corn  
that is to say Wheat and Oats per  
Barrel of Wheat of 20 stoves and  $1\frac{1}{4}$   
stoves of oats ascertained from the  
said Gazette for the period of 7 years  
preceding this application shall bear  
to the said sum of  $1-4-10$  Sterling  
the average price of corn that is to say  
Wheat and Oats per Barrel of 20 stoves  
of wheat and  $1\frac{1}{4}$  stoves of oats ascer-  
-tained from the said Dublin Gazette  
for the 7 years preceding the 1st day  
of November 1821 being the period

in reference whereto the said composition  
was calculated and that the assessment  
and apportionment of such composition  
shall be diminished so as to bear  
the like proportions to the amount  
of composition for and during such  
next ensuing seven years as the  
Original assessment and apportionment  
did bear to such original composition  
And that the Annual Rent Charge  
payable in lieu thereof shall be  
diminished in like proportion that  
is to say from the sum of  $120$   
Irish currency equal to  $120$   
Sterling to the sum of  $71-19-7$   
Sterling
