

November next ensuing shall bear the like proportion to the amount of the Composition set forth in the said Certificate dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 1824 as the said sum of  $\pounds 110$  the average price of Corn that is to say Wheat and Oats per Barrel of Wheat of 20 stones and 14 stones of Oats ascertained from the said Gazette for the period of 7 years preceding this application shall bear to the said sum of  $\pounds 110$  sterling the average price of Corn that is to say Wheat and Oats per Barrel of 20 stones of Wheat and 14 stones of Oats ascertained from the said Dublin Gazette for the 7 years preceding the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1821 being the period in reference whereunto the said Composition was calculated and that the assessment and apportionment of such Composition shall be diminished so as to bear the like proportions to the amount of Composition for and during such next ensuing several years as the original assessment and apportionment did bear to such original Composition and that the annual Rent charged payable in lieu thereof shall be diminished in like proportion that is to say from

the sum of  $\pounds 130$  Irish Currency equal to  $\pounds 120$  Sterling to the sum of  $\pounds 71.19.7$  Sterling
